DJURGAARDENS is the largest most famous sporting club in Sweden. Formed in 1891, the club has seventeen sections, catering for sports as diverse as skiing, lacrosse and bobsleigh. DJURGAARDENS F.K, the football club has spent most of it's life in the Swedish first division, being champions eight times (the last time in 1966); last season they finished fifth.

Djurgaardens were one of eighteen clubs invited to the meeting in Paris which inaugurated the European Cup. Among the others were Real Madrid, Moscow Dynamo, A.C. Milan and Chelsea. The competition began in the 55/6 season and Djurgaarden

lost 4-1 on aggregate in the quarter final to Hibernian.

They met Man. United in the Fairs Cup in 64/5, but went down 7-2 on agg. The Swedes other match against a British side came in 75/6 in the Cup Winners Cup when they also went down, 3-2 on agg. against Wrexham.

Djurgaardens are amongst a small band to have appeared in all three major European Competitions.

Managed by Alan Ball Snr; tonight's side includes four present internationals, Anders Gronhagen, Lars Stenbeck. Ronald Aman and Tommy Berggren (the club's leading scorer). Also included in the side is former Rapid Vienna star Sven Lindman (21 caps), Curt Olsberg, a Swedish under 21 cap, Former Tranmere Rover Gary Williams, and hopefully a gentleman who should need no introduction - Arsenal's SUPERMAC - Malcolm MacDonald - who is on loan after his series of operations in order to regain his form.

Sweden, a country covering 173,665 square miles and a population of 8,200,000, has 6011 teams and 152,548 players. Another of those 6011 will be here next Wednesday when we entertain I.F.K. Falkoping.


